



Using the Site function via a Gateway connection

This document explains how the Site function can be used through a gateway connection (Cloud Gateway and Casambi app gateway) and what are the current limitations. The presumption for the document is that the networks to be used in the Site are fully commissioned, do not require any further changes, and the (Cloud) Gateway is in place. *(Note that Casambi recommends using the Cloud Gateway for permanent installations and only using the in-app gateway for temporary use).*

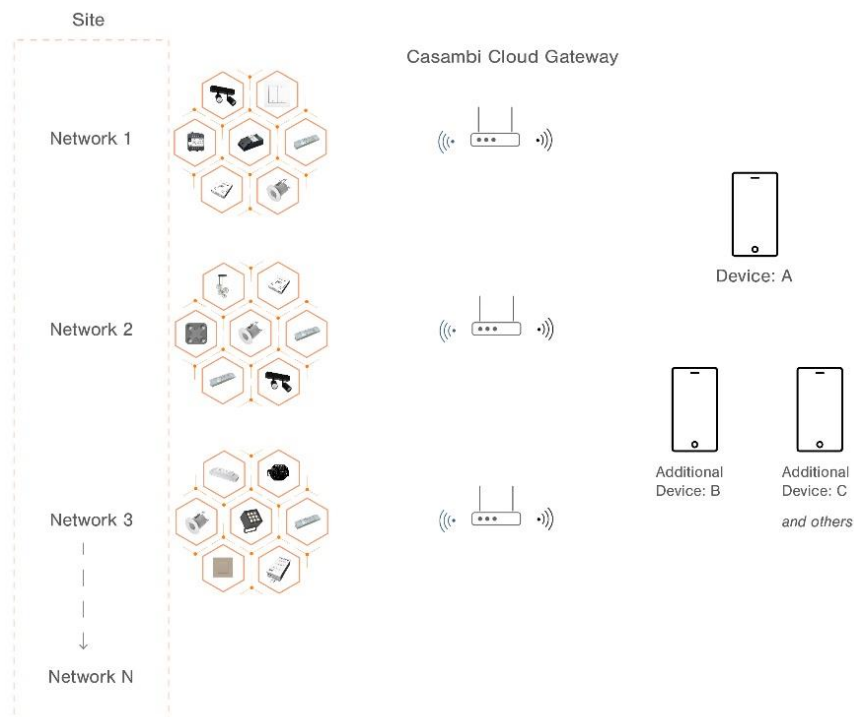

Commissioning the Site

To be able to add a network to a Site the mobile device (phone/tablet) being used for commissioning must be within Bluetooth range of the network or must have been connected to the network previously. It is not possible to add networks to a Site if the mobile device has not previously connected via Bluetooth to the network, even if you know the network login credentials.

Use of the Site from additional mobile devices

Additional mobile devices can log in and access the Site using the credentials set when the Site was created. These devices can be used to observe the networks and to modify/trigger Site level scenes and timers.

Additional devices can access gateway details and add/remove gateways if the device is logged in to the network, login to site is not enough.
